Thank you for your support over the last few months with the stay-at-home orders in NSW. This has been a very challenging time for everyone but keeping our residents and staff safe has been our number one priority.

Our NSW COVID Taskforce has been meeting almost every day during this period in order to maintain vigilance against COVID-19 entering our Homes.

All staff in our Homes have now received at least one dose of a COVID-19 vaccine, in line with Public Health Orders. A small number of staff have not yet received their second dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, and we are working closely with these staff to ensure timely take-up of the second dose. I am very proud of our staff for taking the initiative and helping to protect the very vulnerable people we care for. It shows the respect and commitment they have to our residents.

The NSW Government is starting to ease some restrictions for the general public. We are monitoring this closely and will work with the public health units and our staff to ensure a safe way for everyone to come back into our Homes and visit their loved ones when Public Health Orders allow. We will continue to keep you updated as changes occur.
