We have received updated advice from NSW Health today regarding the further lifting of restrictions in NSW. Visitors are still required to wear a surgical mask whilst in the facility and will be required to complete a screening process, which includes the use the NSW Service App to check in and out. We are asked to exclude visitors who:

- have COVID-19 symptoms fever (37. 5°C or higher) or any other symptoms of COVID-19
- live in the NSW areas of increased testing
- have been to any contact tracing locations of interest in New Zealand
- have been to any of the locations on the close contact or casual contact list at the times and dates listed
- are a close contact of a person with confirmed COVID-19 and are within their selfisolation period
- live in a household with a person who is currently self-isolating
- are waiting for a COVID-19 test result
